# Q. WHAT DO YOU NEED TO PREPARE FOR UNIVERSITY ENROLMENT?

## If you are applying for Undergraduate/Postgraduate Programs

- **1. Copy of Passport** (Must have the same signature as the online form)
- **2.** Copy of Valid NZ visa (If you are living in NZ)
- 3. All of your education qualification (Graduation Certificate & Transcript)
- 4. Your English Certificate (IELTS/ PTE/ TOFEL)
- **5.** Statement of Purpose
- **6.** Updated CV (You need to explain why if you have more than 3months gap period between working or studying)



# REQUIRE FOR SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

## All Documents should be:

- Proper and clearly scanned
- ☐ In colour
- ☐ Up the right way
- Preferably in PDF
- No more than 25MB in size
- ☐ File name should match with document details






- 1. Academic qualification must be in English

- 2. Results from the hospital are automatically sent to the New Zealand Immigration Department via a linked system
- 3. In the medical information sheet received during the medical check, Scan the page with the identification photo and sent to SOL NZ
- Apply for a visa at SOL NZ with the NZER number on the document

- Details about the course you intend to study.
- How it helps to carve your career.
- Your qualification to join the course.

## 4. What aspect of the university do you like?

- Mention the course curriculum along with how it suits you.
- Mention about student community and how you will fit in.
- What fascinates you about the university?

### 5. Why New Zealand?

- Why New Zealand and not your homeland?
- Availability of the course in your homeland
- Why not US, UK, or Canada?

## 6. Career and professional goals

- How do you love to see yourself after completing the course?
- Whether you would like to go for a job or continue with research after completing the course.

### 7. Skill set

 Include activities and interests that can give the admission committee insight into your profile and character so that they can understand that you have the right motivation to pursue the course.

### 8. Return to Home Country

Mention the reasons for a comeback to your home country.

### 9. Conclusion

- Additional information that supports your statement of purpose.
- Thanking and acknowledging you will be on your best behavior while studying at the university.
